Donation for attendance: \$50 or in kind which can be used as a raffle prize. A Tax receipt will be provided.

- Is person prepared to make donation to David Hack? Trade Entry fee \$50 or in kind.
- Can the area required be easily accommodated at the David Hack?
- These three below will not be accepted:
 - Spare parts out of back of cars (not a swap meet)
 - Political advertising displays
 - Products to be sold in competition with Rotary Club of Toowoomba North - food, raffle, drinks.

Conditions

- 1 Copy of Public liability Insurance to be provided prior to 6th May
- 2 Arrival time Saturday 2pm-4pm or on Sunday set up by 9 am.
- 3 You will be told where to set up.
- 4 Need to be self-powered.
- 5 Ideally set up under own portable/ pop up marquees and tables.
- 6 Need to be self-sufficient.
- 7 Vehicles parked at the back fence unless the vehicle is a classic or is a van which is the display product store
- 8 Remove your rubbish and place in bins before departure from aerodrome.



- 9 No loud hailers
- 10 Courtesy and work with any neighbours
- 11 Cannot pack up until 2:00pm
- 12 Offsite no later 5pm Sunday
- 13 Rotary Club of Toowoomba North takes no responsibility for the loss of your stock through theft, accident or other event.
